CORNERED SLOUCH

Sometimes, all you want is a simple, slouchy hat. Knit up a fun yarn or show off some handspun. This simple pattern with squared decreases is the perfect display for your favorite yarn.

Sizes

21", 23"

Gauge

4 sts and 5.5 rows = 1"

Materials & Notions

Aran Weight Yarn - 110 (130) yds

The yarn used for this hat was a fingering weight yarn chain-plied to make to make a marled aran weight. Use a traditional aran weight or ply your own with this tutorial: <u>Create Marled Yarn with Chain Plying</u>.

US 7 (4.5 mm) circular for magic loop OR a 16" circular and Double Points Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations

k = knit p = purl k2tog = knit 2 stitches together ssk = slip 1 st purlwise, slip 1 st knitwise; knit the 2 sts together st(s) = stitch(es)

Cast On, Ribbing, & Body

Cast on 76 (84) sts with the long-tail cast on. Work 12 rows of k2,p2 ribbing. Work stockinette until hat measures 8" (8.5") from cast on.

Crown Decreases

Begin decreases for 21" hat at Round 3 or Round 1 for 23" hat. If you're using a 16" circular, switch to double points when there aren't enough sts to go around.

Round 1: *k2tog, k16, ssk, k1*, repeat between * * a total of 4 times Round 2: k all **Round 3:** *k2tog, k14, ssk, k1* Round 4: k all Round 5: *k2tog, k12, ssk, k1* Round 6: k all Round 7: *k2tog, k10, ssk, k1* Round 8: k all Round 9: *k2tog, k8, ssk, k1* Round 10: k all Round 11: *k2tog, k6, ssk, k1* Round 12: k all Round 13: *k2tog, k4, ssk, k1* Round 14: k all Round 15: *k2tog, k2, ssk, k1* Round 16: *k2tog, ssk, k1* Round 17: *k2tog, k1*

Cut yarn and pull through the last 8 sts to close. Weave in ends.
