## HAPPY BIRTHDAY SOCKS

# With

I cast on for these socks during a road trip because I thought they'd be a great birthday gift for myself and easy travel knitting. They did not disappoint.

#### Sizes

7.5" (8.5") with adjustable length

#### Gauge

7 sts and 9 rows = 1" in stockinette

#### **Materials & Notions**

DK/Sport Weight Yarn - 250 yds
Shown in MacKintoch Yarns Chubby Sock - Sex Kitten
2.75 mm needles (DPN's or Circulars) OR size needed for gauge

Stitch Markers

Tapestry Needle

### **Abbreviations**

k = knit p = purl k2tog = knit 2 stitches together p2tog = purl 2 stitches together ssk = slip 1st st as if to knit, slip 2nd st as if to purl; insert the left needle into the front of the stitches and knit together LLinc = insert left needle into the left leg of the stitch 2 stitches below last worked stitch and put it on the right needle; knit into the back leg LRinc = insert right needle into the right leg of the stitch below the next stitch and put it

- on the left needle; knit
- w&t = wrap and turn

st(s) = stitch(es)

#### Тое

Using <u>Judy's Magic Cast On</u>, make 10 sts on each needle.

Round 1: knit 1 row Round 2: \*k1, LRinc, knit to last stitch on instep, LLinc, k1\*, repeat once more.

Repeat these two rows until you have 44 (56) sts on the needles.

### Foot

Knit in stockinette until the sock measures 3" (3.75") less then the length of the foot. On the last row before the gusset, k31 (40) sts, place marker, k4, place marker, knit to end of round.

#### Gusset

Round 1: Knit to marker, LRinc, slip marker, k4, slip marker, LLinc, knit to end of round. Round 2: Knit all.

Ending with Round 1, repeat these two rounds until there are 66 (84) sts on the needles.

Round 3: Knit across instep, k12 (15), LRinc, k 10(13) sts, LRinc, k10 (13) sts, LLInc, k12 (15).

#### Heel

Knit across the instep, knit the 11 (14) gusset sts, and work the heel over the next 22 (28) sts:

Row 1: \*k1, slip 1\* to last 2 sts, w&t Row 2: purl to last 2 sts, w&t Row 3: \*k1, slip 1 in pattern\* to last 3 sts, w&t Row 4: purl to last 3 sts, w&t

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Row 5: \*k1, slip 1 in pattern\* to last 4 sts, w&t Row 6: purl to last 4 sts, w&t Row 7: \*k1, slip 1 in pattern\* to last 5 sts, w&t Row 8: purl to last 5 sts, w&t

**Row 9:** \*k1, slip 1 in pattern\* to last 2 heel sts, ssk, turn

Row 10: slip 1, purl to last 2 heel sts, p2tog, turn

Row 11: slip 1, \*k1, slip 1\* to last heel st, ssk the last heel stitch together with the first gusset st, turn

Row 12: slip 1, purl to last heel st, p2tog, the last heel stitch together with the first gusset st, turn

Repeat Rows 11 and 12 until 2 gusset sts are left on each side. End on a purl row.

Slip 1, \*k1, slip 1\* to last heel st, ssk the last heel st with the first gusset st and resume knitting in the round. Knit across the instep to the second gusset st and k2tog the gusset st and the first heel st. Knit all heel sts. Ssk the last gusset st and the first st of the instep, knit to last st of instep and k2tog with the last gusset st on that side. Finish the round in stockinette.

#### Cuff

Work in stockinette until the cuff measures 2". Work 2 x 2 ribbing for another 2".

Note: If you're working the 7.5" size then you can make the cuff a little longer.

Bind off using <u>Jenny's Surprisingly Stretchy</u> <u>Bind Off</u> or EZ's Sewn Cast Off.
