Sideways Towel

SIDEWAYS TOWEL

After making my umpteenth kitchen towel, I was ready to try something a little different. So, this towel is worked from side to side in a simple stitch pattern instead of the usual bottom to top.

Size

8" x 15" (20.3 x 38 cm)

Gauge

5 sts = 1" (2.5 cm) in pattern

Materials & Notions

Worsted Weight Cotton Yarn - 95 yds Shown in Lily Sugar'n Cream Naturals -*Earth Ombre* US 7 (4.5 mm) needles Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations

k = knit p = purl st(s) = stitch(es)

Cast on 73 sts (or any increment of 5 + 3)

Row 1: Slip 1 st as if to purl, knit all Row 2: Slip 1 st as if to purl, p2 (k2, p3) to last 3 sts, p3

Repeat these 2 rows, ending on row 1, until cloth measures 8" (38 cm) from the cast on edge.

Bind off in purl and weave in ends.
